

The Dugan Foundation mission is to develop a sustainable no-kill community in Pierce County. We do so by providing grant funding and business leadership to local/selected animal welfare organization. Grants are provided for work in any one of the four project areas:

- Sheltering - kennels, runs, bath/groom, etc.
- Care - medical, behavior, spay/neuter, etc.
- Adoption - consultation, training, follow-up, etc.
- Education - humane education programs and implementation

Last year Foundation grants funded over 700 spay/neuter surgeries in Pierce County and launched the first ever mobile spay neuter program serving low income individuals. The more we raise, the more we can do. Long term sustainability and ability to save the lives of homeless companion animals is dependant on endowment funding.
